This project deals with one of the priority issues identified by the European Commission in the field of the “innovative approaches to managing change”: the management of demographic change, understood as the promotion of initiatives for the active ageing of the population and the increase in employment levels of elderly workers.

This project has been selected by the European Commission as a best practice and presented by IFOA to the “1st Forum on the demographic future of Europe”, in Brussels on 30-31 October 2006, in the presence of more than 500 EU and non-EU delegates of ministerial and governmental level.

Development of innovative ICT training paths, certifiable at European level, with the participation of the largest companies in the sector (IBM, Cisco, Nokia, Wind, Microsoft, Alcatel), social parts (Assinform, CGIL Training and Research Federation), transnational partnerships (France, Great Britain), and other institutional partners (Regions, Regional Employment Agencies, etc.). In 2004 this project was considered a European “good practice” by CEDEFOP.
